## Mazes from Home

Mazes are a fun way to make use of old boxes and cardboard. You probably have some old boxes that came in the mail during this week and they are a great based for your Maze. You can make a Small maze that goes one level or a multi-level maze. Here are some Ideas but you can find more on the internet that are more complex.

### 1. Materials

- a. Box
- b. Large sheet of cardboard
- c. Scissors
- d. Hot glue
- e. Hot glue gun
- f. Pencil
- g. Ruler
- h. Several boxes
- i. Duct tape
- j. Utility knife

### 2. Small Maze

- a. Set your cardboard box so that the open top is facing up, as if you were going to pack it with something.
- b. Draw the solution path for your maze on the bottom of your box with your pencil.
- c. Draw misleading paths now on the bottom of your box, around the solution path so the solution isn't too easy to find.
- d. Measure the lines that you have drawn with a ruler so you will know what you need to cut from your cardboard sheet.
- e. Cut walls for all the lines that you have drawn on the bottom of your box from your cardboard sheet.
- f. Hot glue the maze walls in place.
