Service & Advocacy From Home

Did you know that you can make a difference without even leaving your neighborhood? The following ideas are just a few ways that outdoor projects can make a positive impact in your community during COVID-19 or ANYTIME throughout the year.

- #1** Go on a walk around your neighborhood and collect trash! Ask your parent/guardian before leaving your house or apartment, and be sure to wear gloves!
- #2** Ask your neighbors if they need help with their trash cans or yard work. Can you help everyone on your street by being Captain Trash Can on pickup day, and move everyone's bins to and from the curb? Can you rake leaves, mow the grass, or pull weeds from flowerbeds? With your parent's or guardian's permission and assistance, find out how you can help your neighbors.
- #3** Ask your parent/guardian about walking your neighbors' dogs. Some folks are not able to leave their homes at all during this time. Make a plan with the adults in your life to pick up and return the dogs like placing them in the backyard, or using a long lead that allows you to maintain a safe distance between you and your neighbors.
- #4** Start a garden! Plant veggies to eat or flowers to attract pollinators in your yard. You can help the world by helping bees find food and flowers!
