Story Telling for Kids and Senrios

All of us have a story to tell or have the opportunity to share and read to a someone else. Here are some ideas that you can use to create or tell stories

- Create a story. Decide if it is one that you want to tell with photos, pictures, or props. Using a cell phone or video, record yourself telling the story. Share the story with a friend or with a child in your life. Write the story out so that you can remember it in the future.
- Choose a book that means a lot to you and using your cell phone, video the story as you read it. Make sure you are showing the book in the video and that you are using expression in telling the story. As you read, ask questions and wait a few seconds so that the person listening to the story can answer your questions. Save your video and share it with us and we will post it on our YouTube channel. This is a great service project. If you use another language you could read the book in that language such as ASL, Spanish, or French .
- Using Facebook Live, Duo, or Facetime, tell a story to a child in your life. This could be one of your classmates or it could be a family member. For senior citizens it is a good way to connect with children in your family.
